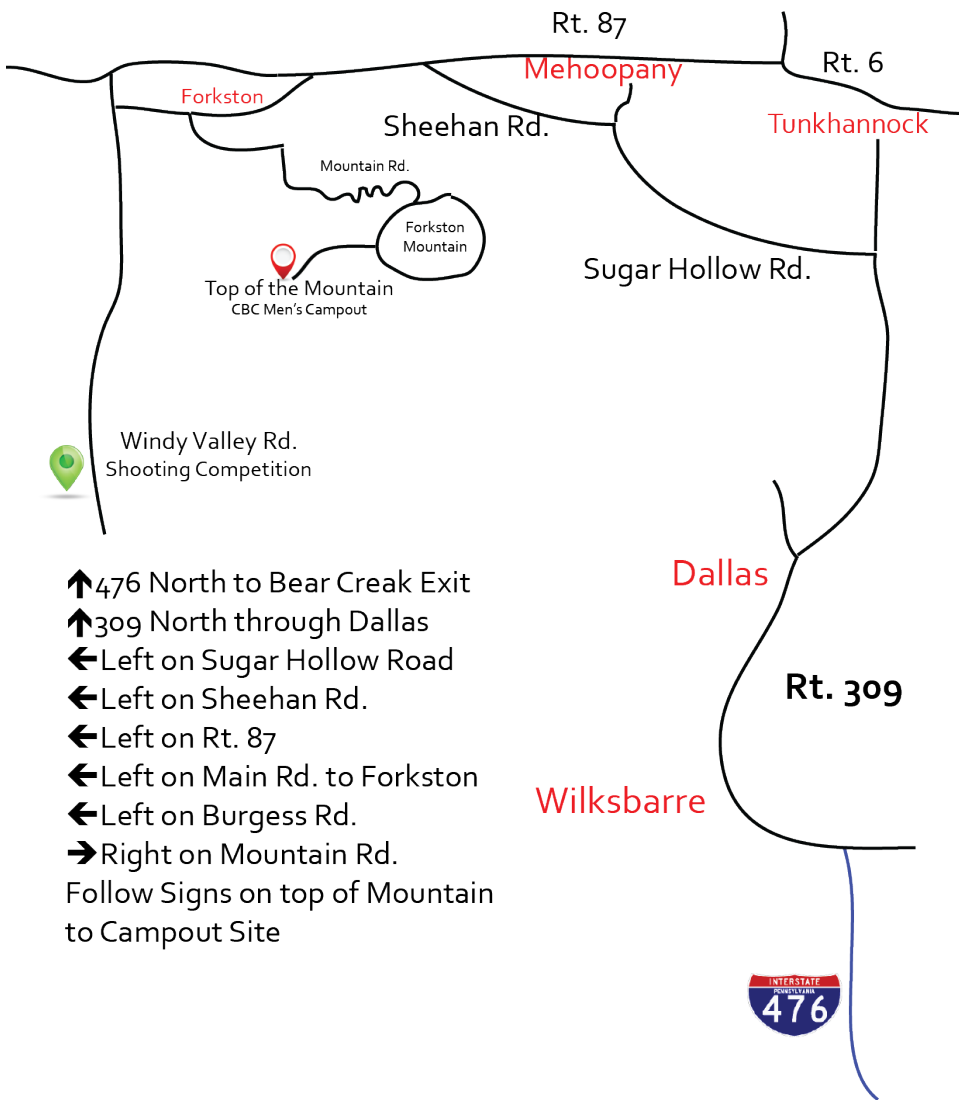


Directions to Forkston Mountain CBC Campout
